ORDINANCE NO. 387-2010

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CONCRETE PIPE FOR ALL STORM WATER SEWERS INSTALLED IN STATE RIGHTS-OF-WAYS OR EASEMENTS IN THE CITY OF SPANISH FORT, ALBAMA

WHEREAS, the City of Spanish Fort has a significant governmental interest in protecting the health, safety and welfare of the general public in preserving the longevity of the State right-of-ways; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to require enhanced structural capabilities for all new culverts, storm water pipes and inlet boxes installed within State right-of-ways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SPANISH FORT, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Requirements for use of concrete pipe.

Reinforced concrete pipe and pre-fabricated concrete or poured-in-place concrete inlet boxes shall be required for all proposed storm or newly installed State right-of-ways and easements.

SECTION 2. Repealer Clause.

Any ordinance heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Spanish Fort, Alabama, which is in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. Severability Clause.

If any part, section or subdivision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed to invalidate or impair the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect notwithstanding such holding.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption or as otherwise required by state law.
